**D.1. Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) Ionospheric Experiment**

The Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) has requested use of Inverness Airport property for an ionospheric research experiment scheduled for December 2025, with the possibility of slipping into early 2026. The project would require approximately three weeks on-site, including setup, the experiment, and breakdown. AFRL plans to install a 40-foot transmit antenna, a four-element receive array, and an electronics unit housed in a weather-protected shelter, all positioned within about 500 feet of each other on airport grounds. The site offers the necessary open space, power access, and flexibility for the antennas and support equipment. AFRL will secure required frequency authorizations and is experienced in coordinating with FCC and FAA requirements.
