February 10, 2022
Meeting Minutes

The Citrus County Aviation Advisory Board (AAB) met in regular session on Thursday, February 10, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. in Room 166 at the Lecanto Government Building. Fill-In Chairman George McDonald called the meeting to order after determining that the AAB had a quorum.

Present: Luis Michaels, Jim Booth, George McDonald, Heiko Kallenbach, Marc Gorshe, Carl Douglas Flanagan, Charles Carr, Commissioner Holly Davis, Joe Hochadel, Quincy Wylupek, Brian Kauffman, Charles Leazott, Andy Chan, Shavonna Reid, Hugh Emmons, Mike Bays, Dave Lewis, Reese Bilby, Elaine Thomas

Absent: N/A

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- A motion was made by Heiko Kallenbach to approve the January 20, 2022, meeting minutes.
- Motion seconded by Luis Michaels.
- Motion approved unanimously.

OATH OF OFFICE:

- Reese Bilby performed the swearing in of the newly appointed members: George McDonald, Jim Booth, Charles Carr, Carl Douglas Flanagan.
- Heiko Kallenbach elected Chairman
- George McDonald elected Vice-Chairman

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC: Commissioner Davis brought the following issues before the Board for discussion: working on strategic plan for the County; having the AAB meetings held at each of the airports every other month; placing the AAB agendas on the County website; and, noted that she sees the Inverness Airport more for business use and the Crystal River Airport more for personal use.

Andy Chan discussed the following: having the VirTower system at the Inverness Airport; the glider school at the Inverness Airport; flight training at the Inverness Airport and how to lower the cost; bringing Pipistrel aircraft production to Inverness Airport (5–10-year plan); the Withlacoochee Technical College is in the process of submitting and finalizing a grant for approximately \$4,500,000 for a FAA Part 147 approved Airframe and Powerplants (AP) program – timeline is about 2 years; a new grant for the Inverness Airport for a 24,000 sq. ft. hangar; Right Rudder is in the process of receiving 10 electric aircraft; and the need to begin training a replacement for Quincy in preparation for his retirement.

Dave Lewis (former Chairman of the AAB in Leesburg, FL) discussed after hours AAB meetings at the Leesburg airport. Mr. Lewis offered to share his expertise with the Citrus County AAB and that we need Master Plans for both airports. Mr. Wylupek stated we have master plans for both airports, INF was updated in 2015, and CGC was updated in 2017.

Mike Bays (President of Economic Development) discussed how our airports mean a great deal to Citrus County and they need to be part of the economic development plan for the County.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Quincy will reach out to Crystal River Airport to see if they would host the AAB meetings every other month. It was pointed out that both Inverness Airport and Crystal River Airport have tables and chairs for such meetings.

Marc Gorshe liked the idea of having the AAB meetings at the airports. Suggested larger ads, and banners at each airport. This should be placed in our budget. Mr. Bays said he will pay for the banners and said that pilots would probably donate money as well.

We should invite the Chronicle to attend the next AAB meeting. We should also do a press release.

A motion was made by Marc Gorshe to move monthly meetings to the airports at 4:00 p.m., with the next meeting on March 10, 2022, to take place at Inverness Airport.

Motion seconded by Carl Flanagan.

Motion approved unanimously. Luis Michaels abstained.

- Need to have the County Attorney come to our next meeting to give a brief education on the Sunshine Law.
- The need for more hangars was discussed. Mr. Wylupek stated there are hangar projects listed in the CIP. There is also the possibility of people building personal hangars on County property.

OLD BUSINESS:

- VirTower Report – Will provide reports monthly. This has a direct connection for future funding. The more traffic that comes to the airports, the more funding we could receive.

A motion was made by Marc Gorshe to expand the VirTower project to Inverness Airport.

Motion seconded by George McDonald.

Motion approved unanimously (except for Luis Michaels, who opposed this Motion).

Mr. Wylupek stated he had penciled this in for the next fiscal year; we will look for funding to implement the VirTower system at INF sooner.

- Wildlife INF – no issues at this time (seasonal problem).
- Security Plan Mtg – INF – We have support of Citrus County Sheriff's office (Special Unit Division). We do need to update the security plan for next year. George McDonald will sit on Security Committee.
- Generator – CGC – will be elevated per FEMA requirements.
- CGC Runway Extension – FDOT was asked to fund the Environmental Assessment. A legislative funding request for \$7,100,000 was submitted for the runway extension.
- Helicopter pad issue – Further discussion ensued. DOT inspector said this was not an issue.

- **CGC Runway Rehab and Obstacle Removal North of Armory** – Project started on 1/31/22 – is moving forward fairly quickly.
- **INF Taxiways B and C and Apron Rehab at North End** – Work is almost done.
- **INF Airspace Study-Obstruction Removal** – Received the FAA grant to do the design but waiting on FAA direction on which obstructions to address first.
- **INF FBO Hangar Door Replacement** – Delayed due to COVID.
- **INF Parking Lot** – Will get project out to bid in about 1 month. This will add approximately 24 spaces.
- **INF Business Park** – A presentation is on the BOCC agenda for 2/22/22. We have been in contact with DEO to request a modification to the scope and for a time extension. With the BOCC's approval, the project should go out to bid in early March. The grant money must be used by the end of June 2023. We are concerned with significant delays in projects due to slow delivery of material and contractors being overbooked.

The Citrus County Aviation Advisory Board (AAB) met in regular session on Thursday, March 10, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. at the Inverness Airport, 4250 S. Airport Road, Inverness, FL. Chairman Heiko Kallenbach called the meeting to order after determining that the AAB had a quorum.

Pledge of Allegiance

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- A motion was made by Charles Carr to approve the February 10, 2022, meeting minutes.
- Motion seconded by Carl Douglas Flanagan.
- Mr. Michaels pointed out that the Chairman made a motion at the last meeting, which is not allowed. The motion was corrected and the motion to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2022, was approved unanimously.

Chairman Kallenbach stated that Robert's Rules of Order will be used to conduct the AAB meetings.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC: Commissioner Davis informed the AAB that the legislative funding request for the runway extension at the Crystal River Airport has been approved. The next step is for it to be signed by the Governor.

Barry (did not give his last name) is starting an Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Chapter at Inverness Airport. National rates went up to \$48 per year; \$30 per year for local Chapter.

Mr. Mohammadi discussed the Bi-partisan Infrastructure Legislation Bill (BIL). It provides for billions of dollars to Aviation and a designated amount is required to go to small airports. Andy Chan with Right Rudder will apply for a grant for the Inverness Airport FBO facility. This BIL also allocates \$295,000 for the Crystal River Airport, and \$160,000 for the Inverness Airport, per year.

Andy Chan discussed the following: INF set a record for the first person to receive an electric airplane pilot's certificate at Inverness Airport. Right Rudder just finished US dealer training for Pipistrel.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Aviation Capital Improvement Project Budget – Quincy distributed the FY 2023-2027 CIP and asked for any comments to be sent to him.
- Citrus County Planning Process (Strategic Planning Process) – April 5th and 6th (8AM—4PM) either at the College or LGB. There will be 40 leaders of the community in attendance. There will be open to the public discussions on April 4th. Commissioner Davis asked for an AAB member to attend.

A motion was made by Marc Gorshe to have Heiko Kallenbach attend and represent the AAB; motion seconded by Jim Booth and was approved unanimously.

- The AAB Resolutions were distributed for review. AAB comments will be addressed at the next AAB meeting.
- GPS approaches for RY 09/27 were discussed. The contractor for the Runway Rehab Project will perform the required survey. This data will be uploaded to the FAA system.
- Withlacoochee Technical College is applying for a grant and would like the AAB to assist. They need a letter of support from the AAB saying that the AAB supports the grant request and recommends that they fund the grant. Andy will draft something and send to Quincy. Quincy will then send along to the AAB members. This must be signed by the next meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Moving AAB meetings to the airports – Chairman Kallenbach and Quincy will check out the Crystal River Airport before the next meeting.
- Banners to be placed at both airports were discussed. Someone needs to lay out/design a banner for the AAB's approval. Marc Gorshe offered to assist with this. Chairman Kallenbach suggested giving the banner idea another month. The AAB will decide after the next meeting whether to move forward with the banners.
- VirTower Report – Marc Gorshe would like to see these reports continue. Quincy will seek the funding needed to have the VirTower System put in at INF. Roderick Pitta requested possibly adding something (safety-wise) to the VirTower Report.
- INF Security Plan Meeting – Andy said that Crystal River Airport was targeted for grand theft; the hangar door replacement project at INF is delayed and leaving the FBO vulnerable. The door was supposed to be replaced within 2 weeks. The contractor told Quincy that the skin/siding of the door has not been delivered (as of 3/10/22). Andy stated the Sheriff has an obligation (in their hangar lease) to provide security at INF; however, they did not get back to Andy for 1-1/2 weeks. Commissioner Davis will talk to the Sheriff, but she knows they are understaffed.
- Andy Chan stated that Right Rudder has been contacted by several different agencies regarding a problem tenant.
- Generator – CGC – Generator was raised per FEMA requirements. The power will have to be turned off to the building to complete the installation process; this is being scheduled.

- Will report back about the banners at the airports – there may be sign restrictions.

STAFF REPORTS: (Quincy Wylupek, Project Manager)

- **CGC Runway Rehab and Obstacle Removal North of Armory** – Asphalt milling, and resurfacing is done. There were delays in getting the temporary striping done but it is now completed. Sub-contractor will be back in 2-4 weeks to do the final striping. All the trees north of the Armory are down.
- **CGC Wetlands Removal Project** – FAA Grant Application for the EA to be submitted to the FAA along with a Wildlife Study and Management Plan which has been completed.
- **INF Taxiways B and C and Apron Rehab at North End** – Still waiting for the permanent striping/markings to be fixed.
- **INF Airspace Study-Obstruction Removal** – No word from FAA.
- **INF Parking Lot** – Construction plans are done, bid documents are being prepared.

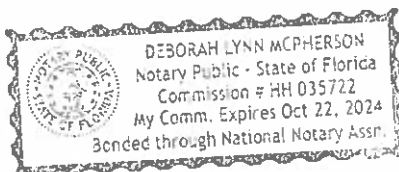
