6. SPECIAL REPORTS

a. Trees and Mowing - Ronald Linton

Trees and Mowing -

- Mr. Linton reported that the grass is dormant and is in great shape.

- The litter crew will be contacted to remove a bag of litter left on Forest Ridge Blvd.

- The trees need trimming from Forest Ridge Blvd. in the South bound lane towards the library.

- There is a dead tree standing in the park.

- No new litter signs have been installed.

- The sidewalk project on Forest Ridge Blvd. is moving along.

- South bound on Forest Ridge Blvd. and Lecanto, the spotlights on the marquee sign are not working.

- The marquee sign needs pressure washing.

b. Medians - Richard G. Fontaine

Medians -

- A tree is lying on the roadside by Black Diamond on 491.
- The mowing crew has not been wearing their safety vests while working.

c. Public Works-Jim Barrows

Public Works -

- Mr. Barrows read the Public Works Maintenance Report.
- Water intrusion into the asphalt base is causing potholes on Forest Ridge Blvd. When the contractor is completed with the sidewalk project, resurfacing will continue. Sections of lime rock base will be removed and replaced with a black base before overlaying the rest of the roadway. The drainage will be improved and intercept some of the water

d. Parks/Community Building- Constance Martin-Carter

Parks/Community Building -

- Tree branches are hanging low over the path in Roosevelt Park.
- Grounds Maintenance will be contacted to clean up the dead brush by the park fence.
- Mrs. Martin-Carter thanked the staff for their work done in the parks

e. Overall Maintenance-Donald Osterhoudt

Overall Maintenance -

- The DRA on the right side of Roosevelt Blvd. and Forest Ridge has shrubs that need trimming. For nearly a year, the Department of Corrections inmate crew have not been available to do landscaping. Due to a shortage of prison guards and three prisons in the state closing, the workforce was redistributed. Mr. Brock has been in touch with the State to see if it remains to be a viable program.
