7. OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Sterling is waiting on quotes for pressure washing the Beverly Hills entrance signs as additional services needed for mulching and tree trimming. A motion was made by the Council at the April 11, 2022 meeting to acquire quotes for these services.

- There is a 1:30 pm public hearing on May 10, 2022 for the Beverly Hills MSBU ordinance amendment. When the ordinance is executed, another public hearing date will be set for adoption on June 14, 2022.

8. NEW BUSINESS

There are approximately 130 streetlights in Beverly Hills funded by the MSBU. An additional 12 more streetlights are desired as well as at a school bus stop area on Valerian Pl., Honey Locust Dr. and Tamarisk Ave. Funds are currently not available in the MSBU budget

9. GENERAL DISCUSSION

An overhanging tree on the last block of S. Adams Street needs trimming.

- A date has not been announced for the continuation of the SCOP Project that will deal with the underlying drainage issues.
- Forest Ridge resurfacing was rebid, as prices have increased. One year ago, price per ton was \$110, this year \$175 per ton, and current prices are coming in at \$325 per ton.
- Road Maintenance is down 15 employees. The County is working out a way to help new trainees get their commercial license and stay for one year employment.
- BOCC will be setting a public meeting date for the MSBU assessment increase.
- Recently, furniture was removed by the park lake where people have been camping out. Crime Watch had been contacted.
- Mr. Sterling will check the service request made for litter signs in the medians along 491.
- Tree trimming along Roosevelt Blvd. and Beverly Hills Blvd. has started this week.
- Council members discussed reviewing their MSBU By-Laws and Ordinance at their next meeting.
