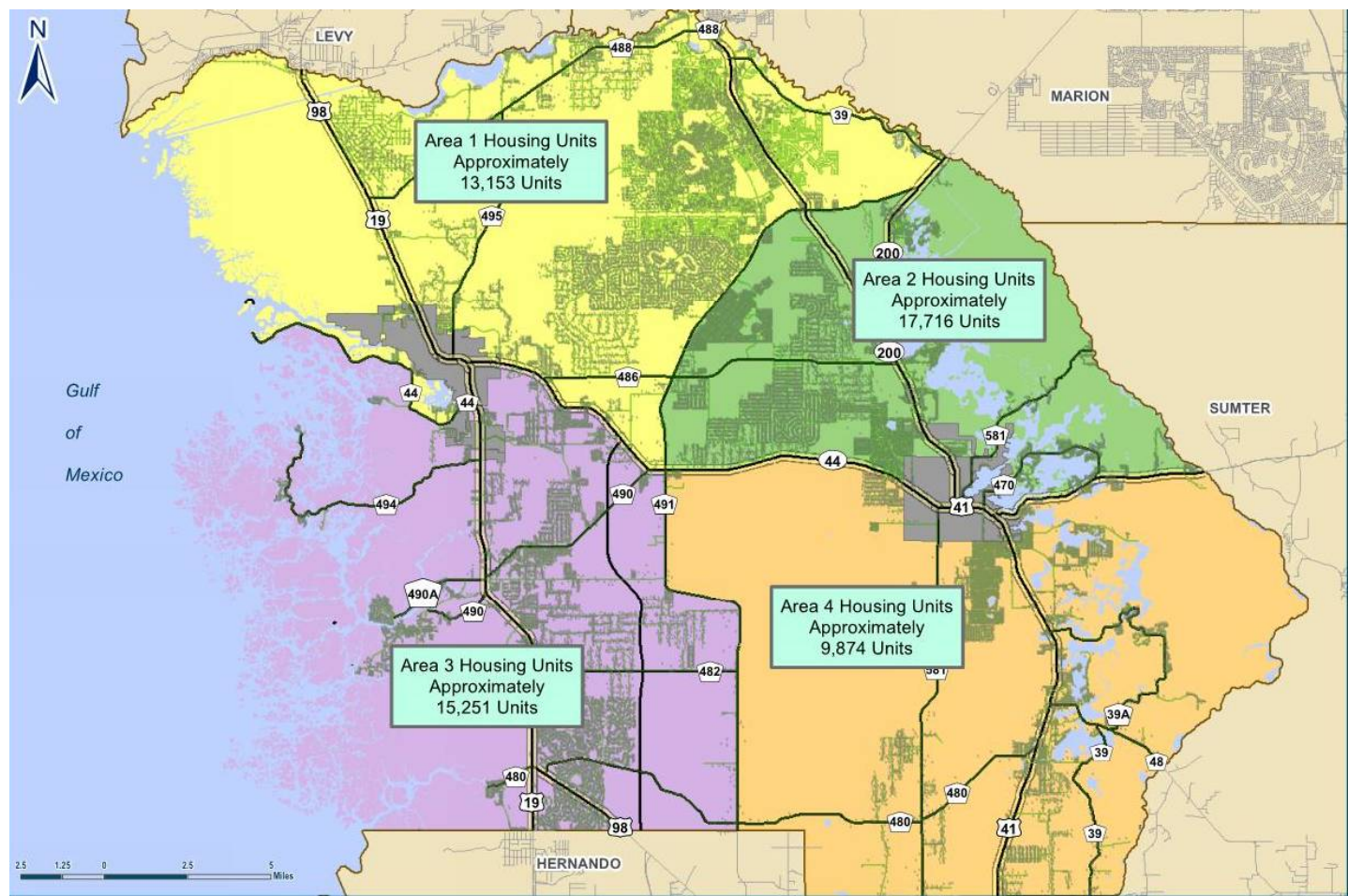

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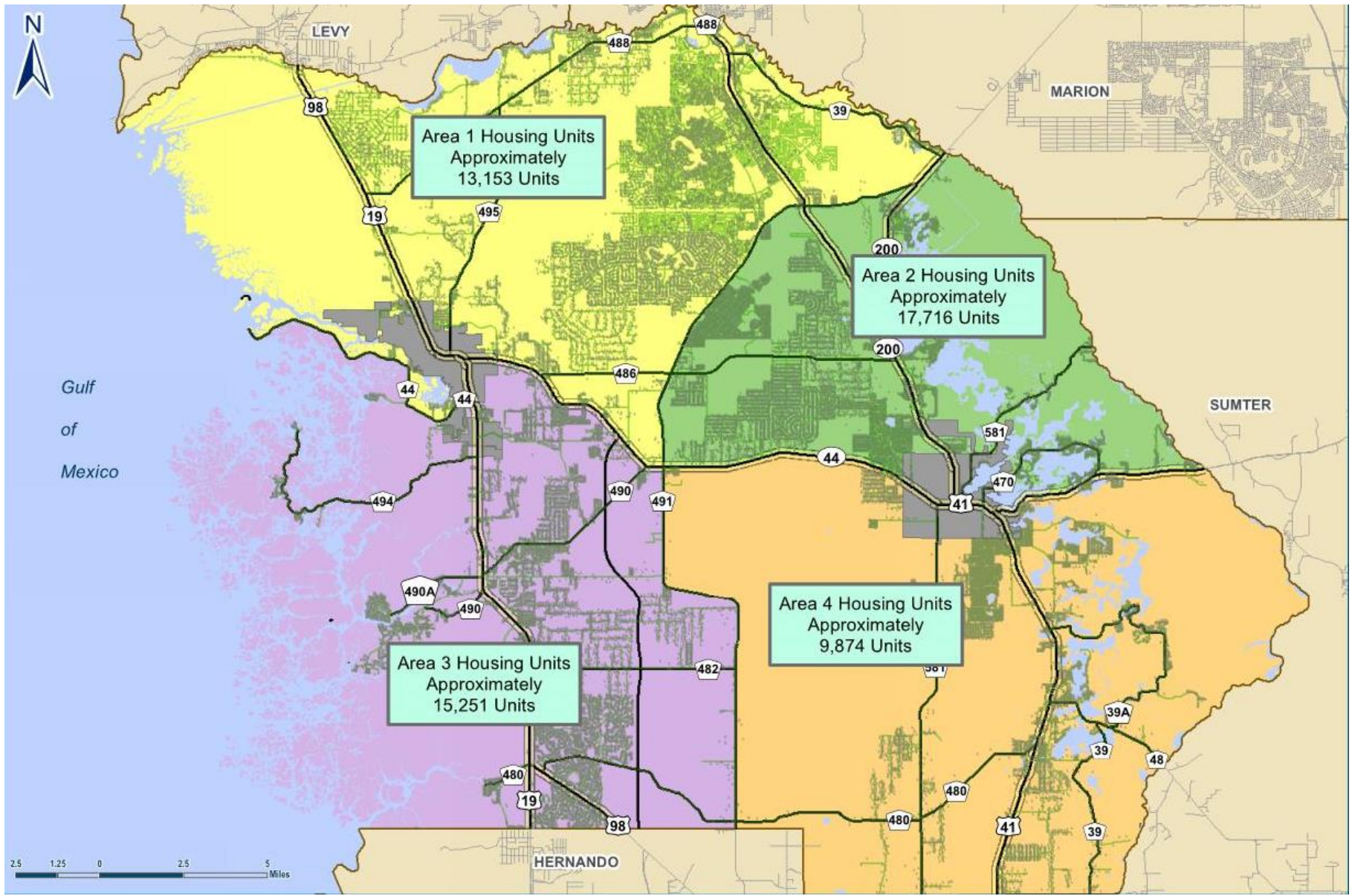

The Citrus County Building Alliance has reviewed the backup for the Special Meeting of November 30, 2021 and has the following questions:

- Will homes on private roads be charged for the new MSBU? If so, are they also eligible for pick up under Universal Collection (UC)?
- Will the county be supplying receptacles? If so, what will the cost to taxpayers be for those items? Will the MSBU cover that cost?
- Who will handle incoming calls regarding trash pick-up issues; the hauler or the county? If the county, what is that cost to taxpayers?
- What will the impact of UC be on our Landfill?
- Have all costs and fees of UC been fully disclosed to the public, for the purposes of transparency.
- If all costs and fees to the taxpayers have not been fully disclosed, why is tomorrow's meeting not a public hearing or workshop?

The CCBA continues to promote full-disclosure and transparency on any item that stands to impact the tax base in a major way. We respectfully request full disclosure on all costs to the public, before any vote takes place.

I urge the county administrators and other relevant staff arrange a week long trip to Cape Coral to observe operations and meet with the administrative staff of the company and city administrators to learn about the history of their initial implementation and lessons learned. The quality and efficacy if properly replicated in Citrus county will certainly evoke drooling of envy from nearby counties!

A way that any extra cost for paying for the upgraded technology for the collection and disposal of large solid waste items would be a special tax on vacant property. This would be of strong benefit to the property owners, especially out of state owners and investors!
