Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Governing Body with respect to any matter considered at this meeting will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose may need to provide that a verbatim record of proceeding is made which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. B. TENTATIVE BUDGET HEARING

B.1. Discuss the purpose of the Public Hearing

Hearings are primarily for the purpose of explaining the budget, proposed tax levy and any proposed amendments, as well as affording the general public the opportunity to participate in the budget process.

B.2. Discuss Proposed Tentative Millage Rates for FY 2023-2024

The Board of County Commissioners proposed tentative aggregate millage rate of 8.8755 mills is a 17.79% increase over the aggregate rolled-back rate of 7.5349 mills. The 2023-2024 proposed tentative millage produces \$120,791,654 in ad valorem tax revenue.
